REGISTER FOR BOSTON ORIENTATION

Reminder: first-year students must attend a two-day, mandatory program with a required overnight. Transfer (including NU Bound) and Veteran students must attend a one-day, mandatory program. We also highly encourage families to participate in Family Orientation that runs concurrent to the Student Orientation.

Check—deadline to register is June 1, 2023.

ORIENTATION TIMELINE

Below is a timeline of what to expect over the summer. As each month approaches, detailed information will be included in the future volumes of HUSKY HAPPENINGS.

Late-May

- Husky 101 Guide: This digital guide details EVERYTHING you need to know and accomplish before starting your first day of classes, such as uploading your Husky Card photo and submitting your University Health Report and Immunization Requirements.
- **Pre-Online Advising:** From late May through June, students will receive communication directly from their college/program to complete online academic advising. **The advising process is unique to each college/program.** Students will hear from their college/program at various times throughout this period. In addition to online advising, there will be an academic touchpoint during Husky 101 Orientation.

Mid-June

- Mandatory Online Curriculum: Required for students, optional for family members. Students will be provided several weeks to complete this 3-hour personalized assignment. Topics include: academics, residential life, campus safety, health and wellness, student involvement, and much more! Access instructions will be provided in HUSKY HAPPENINGS Vol. 3.
- Boston Orientation Confirmation Information: At this time, you'll receive details on your Orientation arrival, such as parking instructions, check-in times/location, and program schedule.

July

• Family Connect: Families will be invited to engage in this premier networking platform, specially designed for you to network with other new families! Access instructions will be provided at the time of launch.

Late August through Mid-September

• **Welcome Weeks:** From the onset of your arrival, students can engage in 300+ programs and activities to meet and reunite with friends, explore campus and the city of Boston, prepare for the fall semester, and most importantly, have fun.
