## Move-in Information

- Students will be assigned a move-in date of either Thursday, January 4, or Friday, January 5.
- Housing assignments and move-in dates will be sent to students in mid-December. You will also receive information at this time about how to request a date change. If possible, students should not book travel until they receive their official move-in date.

## **Husky 101 Student/Family Orientation Information**

- Husky 101 Orientation is mandatory for students and optional for families.
- Students will attend their mandatory session the day following their assigned move-in date.

  - If assigned Friday, January 5 Move-in:
     Saturday, January 6 Mandatory Student Orientation, Optional
