FALL MOVE-IN AND TIPS

All move-in questions and inquiries should be directed to Housing and Residential Life at housing@northeastern.edu.

- Students with Fall university housing in Boston have been provided assignments and **move-in dates**. Requests to adjust move-in dates, which may mean having limited support services, are reviewed on a case-by-case basis through students' Housing Online portals.

- Information on student **mailing addresses and shipping items** to campus mailrooms will be sent this week.
