## **IMPORTANT PROGRAM AND ARRIVAL INFORMATION**

### Husky 101 Boston Orientation Information

Husky 101 Boston Orientation is mandatory for students and optional for families.

- Pre-registration is NOT required. Check-In will take place the day of the program.

### Orientation Parking Instructions

On January 4 and January 5, complimentary day (only) parking is available to our guests in the **Northeastern Columbus Parking Garage at 795 Columbus Avenue, Boston, MA, 02120**. Parking instructions for Move-in will be sent from [Housing and Residential Life](#).

- Upon entering the garage, **pull a ticket**.
- When exiting, **first scan your entry ticket**, and **then the barcode that will be given to you at Orientation Check-In**. Scanning the barcode will remove the fee and open the gate.

### Husky 101 Boston Orientation Check-in

Students will attend their mandatory session the day following their assigned move-in date. The optional Family Program will follow the same sequence.

- If assigned Friday, January 3 Move-in: Saturday, January 4 is the Mandatory Student Orientation and Optional Family Orientation
- If assigned Saturday, January 4 Move-in: Sunday, January 5 is the Mandatory Student Orientation and Optional Family Orientation

Students and families are programmed separately. Families are programmed in the morning, and students are programmed in the afternoon.

7:30-8:15 a.m. in the Curry Student Center West Addition, Lower Level
- **Student Check-In:** *Bring your Husky Card for attendance verification.*  
11:30 a.m.-12:15 p.m. in the Curry Student Center West Addition, Lower Level
